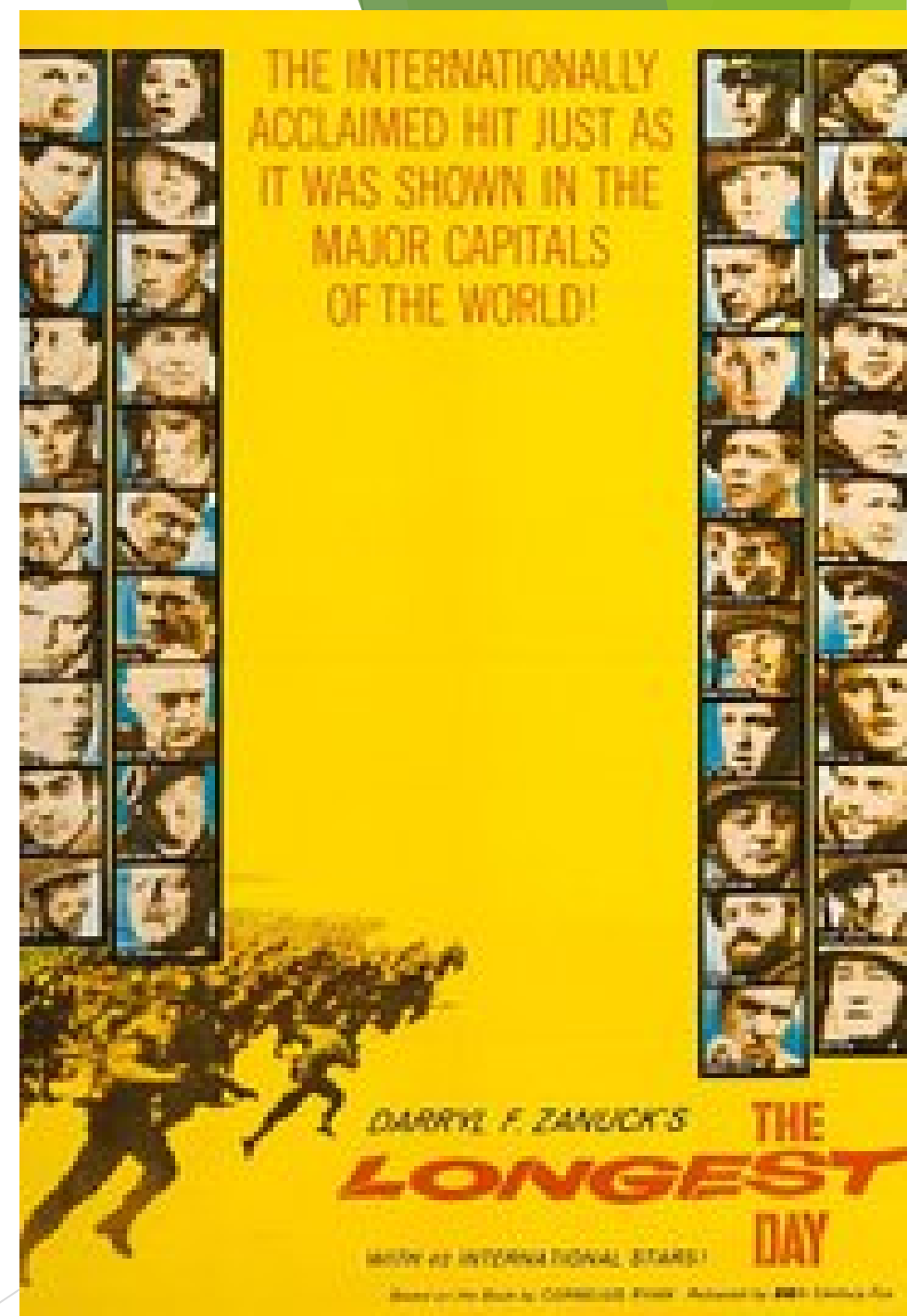


The Longest Day of "Why?"
