Isaiah 43 (KJV)

- ◇ 43 But now thus saith the Lord that created thee, O Jacob, and he that formed thee, O Israel, Fear not: for I have redeemed thee, I have called thee by thy name; thou art mine.
- ◇ 2 When thou passest through the waters, I will be with thee; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee.
- ◇ 3 For I am the Lord thy God, the Holy One of Israel, thy Saviour: I gave Egypt for thy ransom, Ethiopia and Seba for thee.
- ◇ 4 Since thou wast precious in my sight, thou hast been honourable, and I have loved thee: therefore will I give men for thee, and people for thy life...
- ◇ 10 Ye are my witnesses, saith the Lord, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I am he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me.
- ◇ 11 I, even I, am the Lord; and beside me there is no saviour.
- ◇ 12 I have declared, and have saved, and I have shewed, when there was no strange god among you: therefore ye are my witnesses, saith the Lord, that I am God.
- ◇ 13 Yea, before the day was I am he; and there is none that can deliver out of my hand: I will work, and who shall let it?...
- ◇ 19 Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert.
- ◇ 20 The beast of the field shall honour me, the dragons and the owls: because I give waters in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert, to give drink to my people, my chosen.
- ◇ 21 This people have I formed for myself; they shall shew forth my praise.

Lamentations 3:21-29 (KJV)

- ²¹ This I recall to my mind, therefore have I hope.
- ²² It is of the Lord's mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not.
- ²³ They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness.
- ²⁴ The Lord is my portion, saith my soul; therefore will I hope in him.
- ²⁵ The Lord is good unto them that wait for him, to the soul that seeketh him.
- ²⁶ It is good that a man should both hope and quietly wait for the salvation of the Lord.
- ²⁷ It is good for a man that he bear the yoke in his youth.
- ²⁸ He sitteth alone and keepeth silence, because he hath borne it upon him.
- ²⁹ He putteth his mouth in the dust; if so be there may be hope.
